

Zhaomin Hou is a Group Director and Deputy Center Director of the RIKEN Center for Sustainable Resource Science at Wako, Saitama, Japan. He also holds joint appointments as Director of the Organometallic Chemistry Laboratory at RIKEN and as Professor at Saitama University, Tokyo Institute of Technology, and Dalian University of Technology (Thousand Talent Program of China). He received his B.Sc. in 1982 from China University of Petroleum and his Ph.D. in 1989 from Kyushu University.
